## A. EVENT BACKGROUND

1. The event shall be held at the Mapúa MCL Gymnasium (Coronation Night).
2. This event shall be comprised of the following segments:
  - Close-door Interview: Three-minute Private Interviews.
  - Opening Ceremony: Team Jersey Competition (for Parade)
  - Coronation: Production Number, Sustainable Costume Competition, Formal Wear Competition, and Question and Answer Portion

## B. EVENT GUIDELINES

1. Participants of Mr. and Ms. Mapúa MCL shall meet the following qualifications:
  - i. Each department (CAS, ETYCB, MITL, CMET, CCIS, SHS, MIA) must present at least one male and one female candidate, with a maximum of two male candidates and two female candidates.
  - ii. They shall be enrolled in the current term/semester of the school year in Mapúa Malayan Colleges Laguna.
  - iii. Participants shall have registered through the MS Forms. By completing the registration form, all participants agree to adhere to the rules and regulations of the competition.
  - iv. The handler(s) and assistant(s) of each respective candidate shall have also registered through a separate registration form for verification.

### C. EVENT RULES

1. The delegates are allowed to have a handler and an assistant, however, strictly one (1) handler and one (1) assistant only in the holding area will be permitted to assist the delegate.
2. The parents of the delegate must not interfere and must remain in the audience seat.

i. Guidelines and Judging Criteria for the Close-door Interview:

### Close-door Interview Guidelines

- The questions will revolve around the candidate's personality, student life, and the concept of "Building the Future" highlighting the theme of Mapúa MCL's Foundation Week.
- Each contestant will be given the same set of questions prepared, and will be asked by the judges.
- A timer will not be utilized; however, each session is expected to last approximately three minutes per question.
- The final video for each contestant will be edited to a maximum of three minutes per candidate.

- **Age-Appropriateness:** Ensure the costumes worn are suitable for the school's age group and avoid mature themes or suggestive elements.
- **Creativity:** Contestants are encouraged to incorporate recyclable items in their costumes. Above all, they shall wear vibrant-colored costumes that can represent their departments in the best way possible.
- **Technical Requirements:** The costumes must represent the candidate's vision for a better future, aligning with the theme of "Building the Future."

iii. Guidelines and Judging Criteria for the Voice for Innovating a Radiant Future:

### **Voice for Innovating a Radiant Future Competition Guidelines**

- The topic and content of the video must relate to the chosen topic of how they can exude their innovation in building the future.
- The video must zoom in and highlight the candidate's knowledge regarding their chosen topic. It must include ways as to how the contestant incorporates this innovative lifestyle to their daily lives as Mapuans.
- Technical Requirements for the Video: All videos must follow this format. Failure to do so will result in the disqualification of the contestant's video for judging.
- Orientation: Landscape
- Resolution: 1920x1080
- Minimum Duration: 30 seconds
- Maximum Duration: 1 minute
- Format: .mp4

- Age-Appropriateness: Ensure the formal attires worn are suitable for the school's age group and avoid mature themes or suggestive elements.
- Creativity: Contestants shall wear vibrant-colored costumes that can represent their departments in the best way possible.

vi. Guidelines and Judging Criteria for the Question-and-Answer Portion:

### Q&A Guidelines

- The Top 7 male candidates and Top 7 female candidates will proceed with the Question and Answer portion.
  - This Top 7 is based off of the overall score from the close-door interview, Production Number, Voice for Innovating for a Radiant Future, Sustainable Costume, and Formal Wear.
- The questions will revolve around “Building the Future” highlighting the theme of Mapúa MCL’s Foundation Week.
- Each contestant will be given a different question through the ‘lucky pick’ method.
- The host must ask the question twice to the contestant before the three (3) minute timer starts.
- The contestant shall have at least one (1) minute and a maximum of three (3) minutes to answer the question.
- The candidate’s score from the Q&A will be added to their running score, which will help determine the final placements of the contestants.

### People's Choice Competition Guidelines

- Each contestant will be invited for a photoshoot hosted by the CAS SC Department.
- Contestants who are not on the agreed date, time and location of the photoshoot will be disqualified from this competition. The manner of the photoshoot is first come, first serve.
- The photos from the shoot will be posted on Facebook.
- The basis for winning this competition will be from the HEART reactions in the photo of the candidate posted on the page.

## **PENALTIES AND VIOLATIONS**

1. The following summarizes the violations which when committed will result in deductions or disqualification:

<b>VIOLATION</b>	<b>SANCTION</b>
The participants must be at the competition venue at the designated time. The grace period is strictly 10 minutes.	Five (5) points deduction from the total score.
Profanity and other inappropriate language is strictly prohibited.	DISQUALIFICATION
The participant shall be given the discretion to choose any type of costume as long as it is in compliance and inspired by the theme of the Pageant. The decency of all wears must be strictly observed.	DISQUALIFICATION

The participant is not present during the event proper.	DISQUALIFICATION
Failure to comply with the registration process.	Five (5) points deduction from the total score.
The late submission of materials needed such as the music to be used during the actual event.	Five (5) points deduction from the total score.
The candidate is not present during the rehearsals.	Five (5) points deduction from the total score.
The candidate did not utilize recycled materials in the production of their costume.	Ten (10) points deduction from the total score.
The candidate failed to fit the appropriateness of the costume that revolved around the theme and the video.	Fifteen (15) points deduction from the total score.

## **INTERRUPTIONS**

1. The participant shall be given the option to either resume their performance from where it stopped or repeat their entire performance, in case of technical issues brought by faulty event equipment, facilities, etc.
2. If a participant's performance is interrupted due to a failure of the team's own supplies, tools, music, props, acts, or anything of a similar nature, they must either finish their performance or withdraw from the competition.

## **PROPS AND EQUIPMENT**

1. The delegates must not wear and use any harmful props and/or equipment that can harm the audience.
2. The delegates shall inform the Mapúa MCL-CAS Student Council or the Event's Head Organizers prior to the event of the specific list of requirements needed. If failed to inform, the Council is not liable for such.
3. The delegates must maintain cleanliness during their performance. Thus, using props and/or equipment that would clutter the stage is strictly prohibited.
