A. GUIDELINES

a. Participants of E-Sports: League of Legends shall meet the following qualifications:

1. Participants must be bonafide students of Mapúa Malayan Colleges Laguna from the date of registration to the date of execution of games.
2. Professional players are forbidden from participating in the E- Sport. More specifically, Warlocks players and trainees.
3. Participants shall have registered through the MS Forms. By completing the registration form, all participants agree to adhere to the rules and regulations of the sport together with the decision of the referee and the committee.
4. The sequence of the team that will compete must be followed according to the dates provided.
5. The competition will be played at round robin setup, and each team will face other departments once.
6. It is the responsibility of the executive committee to ensure that all players must meet these eligibility requirements and understand both general rules and specific sports rules.

- b. Each team must observe the following conditions:
 - 1. All members of each team should only be students of the respective department.
 - 2. Each department and its chosen players are considered a team.

- b. The race shall be guided by the general guidelines in addition to the rules:
 - 1. The competition will be played at round robin setup, and each team will face other departments once.
 - 2. The top four teams who acquire the most wins will battle in the Semifinals.

B. GAME RULES

A. The Foundation Week 2025 Organizing Committee reserves the right to disqualify any player or team who fails to comply with the competition rules and guidelines. The competition shall be guided by the general guidelines in addition to the rules:

i. A player and team that does not appear 15 minutes after the scheduled time of their game shall be declared in default in favor of the opposing player or team. The devices of the participants will be their own responsibility.

a. **MATCH FORMAT.** The game is played in a competitive game mode. For preliminaries, quarter finals, semi-finals, and finals, the matches will be best of three (3), first to win two 2 matches.

b. Rulebook

i. **In-game Pause.** Marshalls are allowed to pause the game for any reason. Marshalls are ought to notify the reason for the game pause. Once the marshall is ready to continue with the game, both teams shall declare as well their readiness via sending a chat message (e.g., typing “g” or “game”).

ii. **Pause Allowance.** The marshalls may pause the game for up to 10 minutes during the game's duration. Pausing over the allowable period will be considered unfair play, and penalties will be imposed at the discretion of tournament authorities. (This may be extended depending on the problem at hand.)

iii. **Disconnection.** The member/team should attempt to reconnect immediately after disconnection. Failure to reconnect would imply that the game would continue without the said team member.

iv. **Remake.** Remakes can only happen for the following reason.

C. POINT VALUES AND CATEGORIES OF WINNERS

1. Winners will be categorized as the following:
 - a. Champion
 - b. 1st Runner Up
 - c. 2nd Runner Up
2. Special Awards
 - a. Most Valuable Player
3. Scoring System
 - a. Each game is played until a team destroys all the towers and the base of the opposing team.
 - b. The winners during the preliminaries, quarter finals, and semi-finals will be determined through a best of one (1) game setup.
 - c. The winner during the finals will be determined through a best of three (3) game setup.

D. PENALTIES AND VIOLATIONS

a. Team Violations Clause

i. **Lack of players.** If starting members do not reach four people.

1. If teams don't have enough players to play at the scheduled time, the team will be given 15 minutes.

2. If after 15 minutes and the team still doesn't have enough players to play, the game will have defaulted. If a team did not show up to their scheduled game, they are considered forfeit.

3. **Penalty.** Disqualification.

ii. **No Show.** If the team does not show up for the game.

1. **Penalty.** Disqualification.

b. Game Violations

i. Any and all violations that are given by the official game.

E. INTERRUPTIONS

a. Technical Issues

- i. If a player disconnects, the match should be paused immediately.
- ii. Teams can request a rematch for severe technical issues at the discretion of the tournament organizers.

b. Substitutions

- i. Pre-match: Teams can make substitutions between maps or before the match begins.
- ii. In-game: No substitutions are allowed once the match has started.
