



CAMPUS SAFETY AND SECURITY MEASURES

Dear Mapúa MCL Community,

The safety and well-being of our community remain a top priority. In response to recent concerns, Mapúa MCL is strengthening campus security and continuously reviewing its protocols. Please expect additional screening and allow extra time when entering the campus.

What everyone needs to know

- **Wear your Mapúa MCL ID.** The “No ID, No Entry” policy will be strictly enforced. Never lend or use another person’s ID. Report lost or stolen IDs immediately to the Security Office.
* **Students without ID are required to use the Designated Entrance for Visitors**
- **Arrive early and cooperate with inspections.** Bag and vehicle checks may cause longer queues, especially during peak hours.
- **Follow visitor procedures.** Visitors must be pre-registered by their host, present a valid government-issued ID, and enter through the Airwell entrance for official visitor access pass. Visitor passes must remain visible, and visitors must stay within authorized areas.
- **Use designated access points.** Deliveries, contractors, vendors, and service personnel must use assigned receiving or visitor points and comply with verification, screening, escort, and access requirements.
- **Respect restricted areas.** Rooftops, maintenance and utility spaces, service stairwells, and other non-public areas are off-limits without authorization.
- **Plan special events in advance.** Concerned offices must coordinate after-hours and special-event access with Campus Security.

Safety, monitoring, and privacy

The community may notice more security personnel, patrols, facility walkthroughs, and CCTV monitoring in appropriate common and high-traffic areas. Emergency and communication procedures are also being reviewed.

Personal data used for security—including visitor information, identification records, and CCTV footage—will be limited to what is necessary, accessed only by authorized personnel, retained only as required, and handled in accordance with the Data Privacy Act of 2012 and Mapúa MCL policies. IDs will not be copied, photographed, or scanned unless necessary and authorized. Privacy concerns may be sent to dataprivacy@mcl.edu.ph.

Report concerns and seek support

Stay alert and report suspicious or unusual behavior immediately to the nearest Mapúa MCL Security Officer. Do not confront anyone or handle a potentially dangerous situation on your own.
